Fall 2017

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,316 includes 519 new freshmen and 235 new transfer students for Fall 2017. Demographically, sixty-four percent (1,490) of the undergraduates are female, and 69.3% (1,604) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty-four percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,217 (95.7%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 86 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 80.2% of undergraduates.

Approximately 22% of undergraduates have declared a major in Nursing, while an additional 12% have declared Biology and six percent Psychology and Kinesiology – Wellness Management.

Fall 2016

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,332 included 577 new freshmen and 236 new transfer students for Fall 2016. Demographically, sixty-two percent (1,457) of the undergraduates were female, and 68.3% (1,592) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation made up twenty-four percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,229 (95.6%) had Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 82 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties made up 79.6% of undergraduates.

Approximately 22% of undergraduates had declared a major in Nursing, while an additional 12% had declared Biology and six percent Psychology and Kinesiology – Wellness Management.
