Fall 2018

The graduate student enrollment of 1,111 includes 444 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2018 or Fall 2018. Demographically, seventy-five percent (830) of the graduate students are female, and 57.7% (641) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty-two percent of the group. Ninety-one percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Nineteen percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Twenty-five percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs are the MA in Psychology, the MS in Human Resources Management, and the MS in Nursing.

Fall 2017

The graduate student enrollment of 1,009 included 329 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2017 or Fall 2017. Demographically, seventy-two percent (722) of the graduate students were female, and more than sixty percent (630) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty-two percent of the group. Eighty-eight percent of the students were U.S. citizens.

Thirty-seven percent of the graduate students were classified as full-time. Nearly thirteen percent were enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs were the MA in Counseling, the MA in Psychology, and the Master of Business Administration.
