

Role: TRIO Intern (formerly Ambassador)

Reports to: Liaison for TRIO Interns

Days and Times: Flexible as student is available and events arise.

Purpose of Job: TRIO Student Support Services Interns are students who make suggestions for the program, identify concerns and help others navigate the college experience. They are available to talk to students about their TRIO experiences.

Description of Job

Students will:

- Speak at club meetings and classes about the TRIO program and their experiences
- Represent TRIO during college recruiting events
- Assist the staff during TRIO events, activities and trips
- Participate in leadership development
- Participate in and are honored at recognition banquets, etc.
- Provide one-on-one financial coaching for TRIO participants
- Assist participants with financial goal setting, budgeting, credit building/rebuilding, debt repayment, savings, utilization for quality financial services, and asset development
- Monitor participant progress toward financial goals
- Bring a cooperative, enthusiastic and professional attitude to all TRIO activities
- Make a difference!

Special Skills Required: TRIO Interns are TRIO participants interested in enhancing their public speaking and interpersonal skills. TRIO Interns can participate in as many or few events/panels as their schedule will allow (pending minimum requirements). Students interested should also be looking to develop critical leadership skills.

Other: Student must be reliable, trustworthy, show initiative and discernment.

Interview Process: Applicants will be invited to interview with the TRIO Staff. Applicants will be asked to share about themselves and their knowledge of the TRIO Program.
